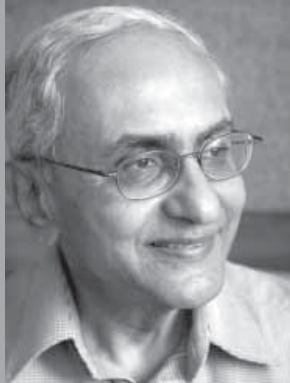

MESSAGE

FROM THE CHAIRMAN



BEYOND EMPATHY, EMPOWERMENT

It is a stark reality of our times that 90% of our senior citizens need to work to survive. They have no option. Nonexistent or marginal social security means almost no state support. Working in India's unorganized sector means retiring without a pension. Breakdown in family structures means living without family support. Newly introduced senior citizens' pension schemes are either too restrictive or grossly inadequate to be of much help. This situation has made it imperative for HelpAge India, as the leading advocate of senior citizens' rights and welfare to step in and make a difference.

HelpAge India is ushering in a quiet revolution by financially empowering senior citizens through livelihood programmes. Senior citizens are being trained in setting up of Elder Self Help Groups (ESHGs) that provide them with income and a sense of self-worth. Senior men and women learn production, distribution and financial prudence in managing these mini cooperatives. Heartening stories of empowerment of once helpless senior citizens prove that this has been a step in the right direction.

Livelihood and income generation schemes have enabled HelpAge India to develop 3445 Elders' Self Help Groups and organize 43,854 elderly under different levels of institutions. For HelpAge India this is only a beginning. Millions of senior citizens still wait to be reached. Great resources need to be sourced and deployed but the task is set and the way ahead is clear. The vision 20:20 document of HelpAge India firmly sets out to ensure adequate income and livelihood for 2 million elderly by 2020 through institutions of the elderly themselves.

Achieving these numbers will take more than mere will. It needs a solid foundation on which to build the delivery mechanism. HelpAge India is already giving shape to this task by helping in formation of Elder Self Help Groups, building their capacity to access micro financing and other livelihood resources and inducting village level volunteers to facilitate these elders groups. These will provide elders with the cherished right to live an active, healthy and dignified life.

In both cases, comprehensive relief was delivered quickly, efficiently and transparently.

In conclusion, I thank the officers and staff of HelpAge India for yet another year of selfless work. I am indebted to our esteemed Board of Governors for their sagacious counsel. Importantly, the most sincere thanks are due to the legions of our donors, both individuals and corporate; they have stood by us through the years. We thank them for their support on behalf of the 100 million senior citizens of the country.

DISASTER MITIGATION

RELIEF TO REHABILITATION

TWO MAJOR DISASTERS HIT THE COUNTRY DURING THE YEAR. UTTARAKHAND AND ODISHA FACED THEIR WORST NIGHTMARES AS NATURE SHOWED ITS WRATH IN FULL FORCE. HELPAGE INDIA TEAMS FACED TOUGH CHALLENGES IN REACHING IMMEDIATE RELIEF TO THE AFFECTED. ON BOTH OCCASIONS, HELPAGE INDIA'S SYSTEMS AND PEOPLE SUCCEEDED IN REACHING TIMELY RELIEF, IN SPITE OF TREMENDOUS ODDS.

UTTARAKHAND FLASH FLOODS - JUNE 2013

In June 2013, Uttarakhand faced the worst natural disaster to hit India since the 2004 Tsunami. Flash floods wreaked havoc on lives, homes, livelihood and left in its wake a horror that haunts many who lived through the disaster.

More than 4000 villages were devastated in the state and it was estimated that more than 5,700 lives were lost. Even those who survived were left without any shelter or food. Roads and bridges caved in after massive landslides at multiple locations, blocking the passage of relief for over 70,000 stranded survivors.

DISASTER RELIEF

HelpAge India started relief work across the three worst hit districts of Rudraprayag, Chamoli and Uttarkashi, targeting 99 villages in the region. Three of its Mobile Medical Units went into remote areas providing medical relief. Around 84 tonnes of relief supplies were distributed by HelpAge volunteers. The first phase of relief work continued through the monsoon season and almost 3,800 families were provided with ration packages containing essential staple food items such as flour, rice, lentil, spices, oil, sugar and salt along with other daily supplies like detergent and matchboxes.

HelpAge India targeted remote villages that had been completely cut off, and had not received any relief. Volunteers and staff walked on foot into the remotest of remote areas carrying supplies on their backs and setting up roadside make-do health camps where access was cut off. Even doctors and paramedics were forced to park the mobile vans when obstructed by landslides and trek, sometimes, up to 12 kms.

Mobile Medical Units were deployed in three of the major affected districts of Uttarkashi, Rudraprayag and Chamoli. The MMUs conducted 800 health camps providing primary health care to nearly 20,000 affected people.

HelpAge worked hand in hand with other local partners. The second phase of winter relief operations started in September with Chief Minister of Uttarakhand flagging off a massive convoy of 18 trucks carrying 90.2 tonnes of relief material. This had to be done on a war footing as the approaching winter posed a new threat to the survivors, who were out in the open without food or shelter. Therefore this time the relief packages also included blanket, shawls, woolen socks as well as a solar lamp.

HelpAge received generous support from several corporates in putting together these relief packages. SJNV Foundation donated two Mobile Medical Units for deployment in the area.

REHABILITATION & SUSTAINABILITY

HelpAge is now concentrating on rehabilitation, providing sustainable options for livelihood.

Kedar Ghati, situated at the banks of the river Mandakini in Rudraprayag district was one of the worst affected areas during the disaster.

Relief Outreach

- MMUS reached disaster sites within 96 hours
- Covered 209 villages in 4 districts
- Provided 200 tons of relief
- Conducted 800 village health camps

Skill & Sustainable Development

- Skill Development in Wool craft taught to women.
- Formation of Elder Self Help Groups in 20 villages for Sustainable Livelihood.
- Restoring pre-disaster livelihood by installing multi-purpose Water Mills.

Long term Healthcare

- A Health & Diagnostic Centre at Village Phata sponsored by HDFC Bank.

Here, 70% of people in the villages have been traditionally engaged in sheep and goat rearing. Developing skills of the locals, especially women, in wool craft is one of the initiatives started by HelpAge in ten of the villages in this area.

In Kedar Valley, HelpAge is also encouraging the community to form Self Help Groups. Forty eight such groups have been formed which are working on alternate livelihood projects such as dairy farming. Water mills are being restored and harnessed to provide electricity and in

turn power many micro enterprises - grinding and milling of grains and irrigation.

HDFC Bank has supported HelpAge to establish a first of its kind, Health and Diagnostic Centre. Services such as medical consultation (both general and specialist), pharmacy, physiotherapy, diagnostic tests and ultrasound are being rendered from this centre.

Establishment of such a centre has not only made the services available to the community, but has also given them access to affordable treatment, unlike earlier when they had to travel up to 150 Km on foot.

ELDERS HELP ELDERS

Village Elders of Bihar donate Rs.5.40 lakh towards HelpAge Uttarakhand Relief work

Elders from 38 villages under 3 districts, and from extremely modest backgrounds accomplished a feat few would have expected of them. 8100 destitute elders from 557 Elder Self Help Groups in the districts of Supaul, Darbhanga and Madhubani in Bihar came together and collected Rs. 5.40 lakh for the victims of Uttarakhand, supporting HelpAge India's Uttarakhand Relief & Rehabilitation initiative.

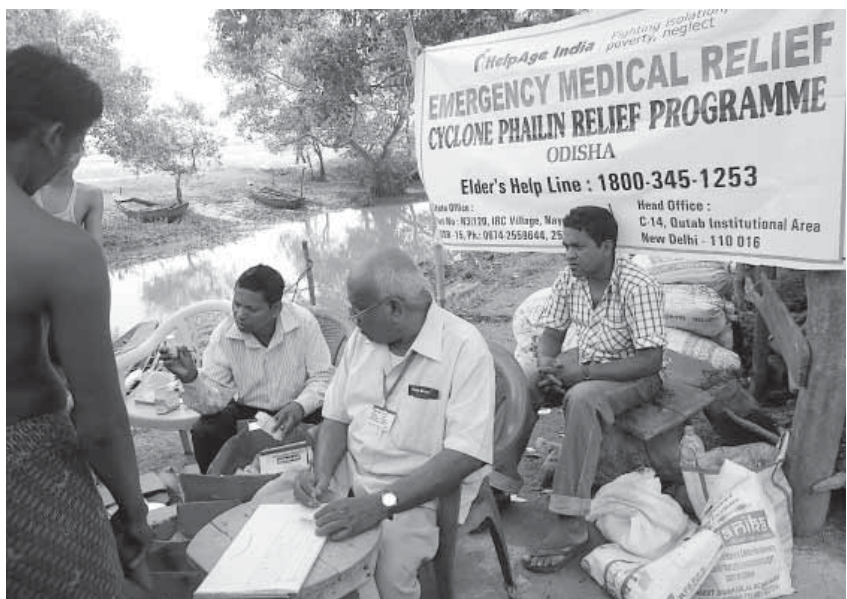

These elders walked from street to street, deep into the villages collecting money ranging from Rs.1 to Rs.150. Some people even donated Dhotis and Saris. *"In 2008 the floods destroyed everything, our houses, our livelihood; we didn't even have food to eat. HelpAge then came forward and helped us. We know what the people of Uttarakhand are going through and we want to help them"* said Siyaram Das, 62 years and member of Elder Self Help Group in Madhubani District.

CYCLONE PHAILIN - OCTOBER 2013

While northern India was still coming to terms with Uttarakhand, Cyclone Phailin struck the coast of Odisha uprooting homes, destroying crops and devastating the lives of over 80 lakh people. Thousands were left homeless and in need of food, shelter, electricity, medical care and livelihood measures. HelpAge India deployed its Mobile Health Service Units to provide immediate relief to the affected areas in Puri, Kendrapada and Ganjam districts. HelpAge India was designated as the Lead Agency for Medical Relief for the worst affected Ganjam District.



LIVELIHOOD

THROUGH ELDER SELF HELP GROUPS

OF THE 100 MILLION ELDERLY IN INDIA, 93% HAVE WORKED IN THE UNORGANIZED SECTOR, PREDOMINANTLY, AGRICULTURE AND OTHER ALLIED ACTIVITIES. THESE ELDERLY WITH NO SOCIAL SECURITY NEED SUPPORT, NEED TO WORK TILL THE END OF THEIR LIVES IN ORDER TO SURVIVE. HELPAGE INDIA ESTIMATES 55 MILLION ELDERLY ARE EITHER CONFINED TO THEIR BED OR HOMES AND HAVE NO ACCESS TO RESOURCES OR SKILLS TO ENGAGE IN CURRENT DAY LIVELIHOODS.

HelpAge India has been for the past 8 years aggregating the rural elderly into Self Help Groups to enable them to collectively access social security, micro-credit and engage in livelihoods. In 2013-14, HelpAge India worked with 3445 Elder Self Help Groups involving more than 45,000 elders across 20 states.

BIHAR,

In Bihar, 924 such Elder Self Help Groups exist that are working on Livelihoods. Each of these groups has adopted one or two destitute elderly and provides them with monthly ration. Every weekly meeting starts with each member contributing a fistful of rice and with an average of 4 kilos of rice for the destitute elders.

These groups have organised themselves into 52 village level



federations. These federations undertake collective farming and marketing, which would not have been otherwise possible for these landless and marginal workers. The Federations also successfully advocate for and monitor Social Pensions for destitute elderly.

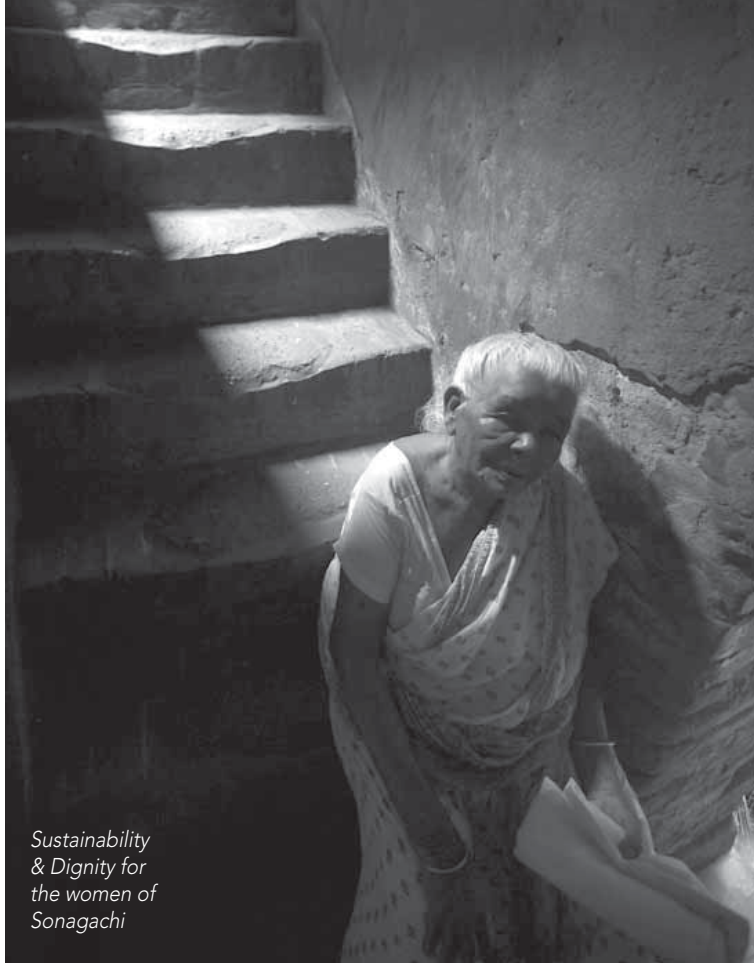
COOCH BEHAR

There are 15 Elder Self Help Groups in three villages in the district of Cooch Behar, West Bengal. 'Ashar Alo' from Kaljani village, is one of these ESHGs formed two and a half years ago. The twenty members, who were all landless labours previously, are now saving and inter-lending on a regular basis for their consumption and livelihood needs.

This year the group applied for a loan through 'Bharat Mata Elders' federation and received a loan of Rs. 59,850 from HelpAge India. They used this money for paddy cultivation and have been making profits after repaying the loan. They paid the land owner with a share in their produce. The group supports four destitute elderly women from their village and has provided clothing and over 100 kilos of rice to them.

They also engage in collective social action. This year for the 'Gadadhar Mela' - a local fair with almost 5 lakhs visitors - the group convinced the organizers to provide tents for women to change their clothes in privacy after the holy bath.

The group believes that selfless work is required for collective actions and it actively promotes formation of more ESHGs by explaining the concept and benefits to their community members.

KOLKATA

Deep from the dark caverns of Sonagachi shines a story of hope. Located in North Kolkata, Sonagachi is Asia's largest red-light district. The area has several hundred multi-story buildings that function as brothels and an estimated 11,000 sex workers live and work in them.

HelpAge India is working to support and rehabilitate elder women earlier engaged in the sex trade, who now have no means of survival, no social or family support. HelpAge through Women's Interlink Foundation runs project "Jonaki" (meaning 'fireflies' in Bengali).

Jonaki supports a group of elder women with monthly rations of food, clothing & daily use items. These monthly rations not just sustain them but often prove to be the reason why their earlier co-workers permit them to continue living within

the community. This shelter is very necessary as almost none of them have any family to go back to or depend on.

These women are also encouraged and trained to take up simple income generation activities such as making bead jewelry, which earns them some pocket money but more importantly, a life of dignity.

"I was brought to Sonagachi when I was 14 years old. This wasn't the trade of my choice, I simply had no voice. Project Jonaki has given me what I couldn't earn in my entire life: a life of dignity."

Tucked away in Chetla (South Kolkata) is a two-storey home that has become a sanctuary for its elderly women residents. This home was made possible by the gracious donation of Mr. K. S. B. Sanyal, HelpAge's Governing Body Member.

Today a model age care facility managed by HelpAge India, Kalyan Ashram is more than just an old age shelter for its residents.

The residents have access to excellent healthcare services and physiotherapy care. The facility also serves as a service-hub for elder care for senior citizens in surrounding areas, providing support through a toll free Elders' Helpline, physiotherapy care and medical services. There are structured art, craft and music classes. The residents create beautiful greeting cards and other handicraft which are sold at various exhibitions and during festivals.

What sets Kalyan Ashram apart is the way the facility is run and the camaraderie amongst its residents and staff.

“Each time I leave Kaylan Ashram to visit my children, I start missing my friends and my life at the Ashram. I invariably return in a couple of days”

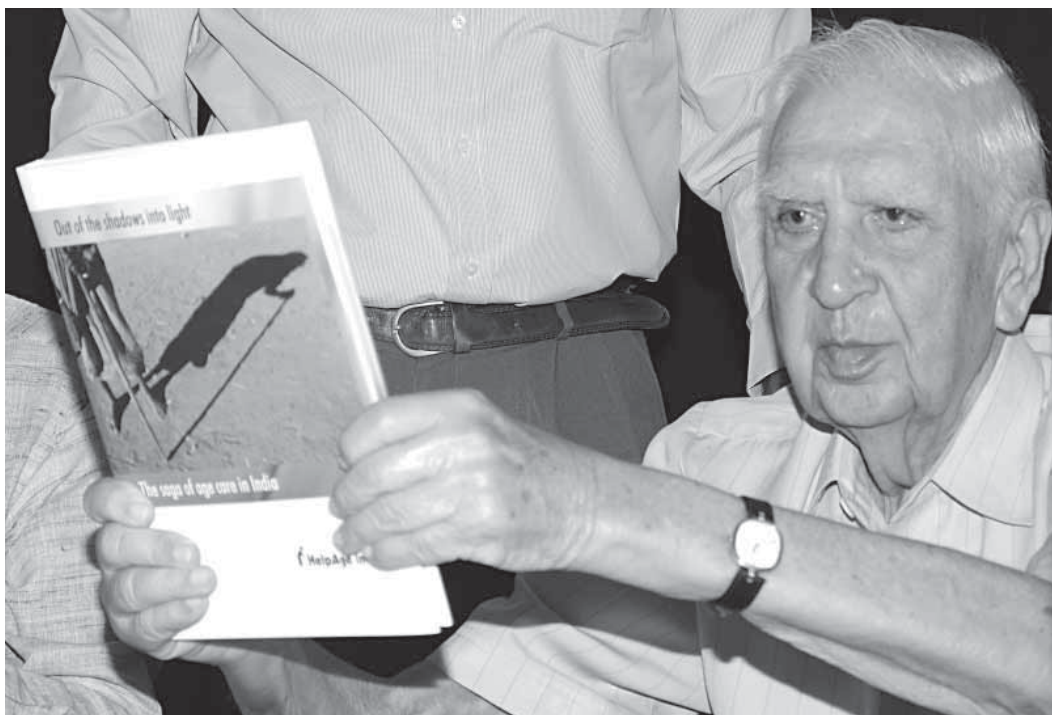

OF THE YEAR GONE BY

GLOBAL AGE WATCH INDEX (GAWI) REPORT RELEASED

The release of the Global Age Watch Index Report of HelpAge International brought out some startling facts: India ranked a poor 73 out of the 91 countries sampled globally in the report. The Global Age Watch Index is calculated as the mean of 4 domains – Income security, Health Status, Employment and Education and Enabling Environment.

India fared poorly in almost all four domains: Health Status ranking – 85, Employment and Education ranking – 73, Enabling Environment ranking – 72 and Income security ranking – 54. Clearly it fared the worst under the health status domain. The aim of the report was to state the hard reality facing the world today in respect of providing a quality life for the aged.

WORLD ELDER ABUSE AWARENESS DAY

The growing instances of crime and abuse against the elderly of our country are a matter of great concern. HelpAge India in an effort to understand the causes and ramifications of crime and abuse against elders, undertook a survey. In year 2006 it released the first report with the findings on 'World Elder Abuse Awareness Day' on June 15. This survey has now become an annual feature as a means of sustained advocacy against this social malaise.

On the eve of 'World Elder Abuse Awareness Day' 2013, HelpAge India released its nationwide report on "Elder Abuse in India". This year's survey on Elder Abuse was conducted in 24 cities of India.

The day was marked across India and the report was released nationally with various signature campaigns, marches and pledges taken to raise awareness on the issue. Events were organized in Maharashtra, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, West Bengal, Assam, Kerala, Puducherry, Chandigarh, Himachal Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Goa and Delhi.

Report 2013 Highlights

- More than one fifth of the elderly (23%) reported experiencing abuse nationally.
- The daughter-in-law was the primary perpetrator of abuse (39%) followed closely by the son (38%).
- The major reasons for abusive behavior include: lack of adjustment, economic dependence of the abused and increasing longevity of the elderly.
- Amongst the most common types of Abuse faced by the elders was Disrespect (79%), followed by Verbal Abuse (76%) and Neglect (69%). An alarming 39% elderly faced Physical Abuse (beating/ slapping).
- 70% of those abused did not report the matter, stating the importance of "maintaining confidentiality of family matter" as the major reason (31%), followed by "fear of retaliation" (23%).
- The elderly surveyed suggested sensitizing children and strengthening intergenerational bonding, increasing economic independence of the abused and sensitizing young adults, as the measures to prevent Elder Abuse.

PL ROY AWARD FOR CONSISTENT CORPORATE SUPPORT - ONGC

A longtime supporter of the cause, Oil and Natural Gas Corporation's association with HelpAge India goes way back to May 2010 when they took up the project called *Varishthajana Swasthya Sewa Abhiyan (VSSA)*, a healthcare project catering to elder needs. 20 Mobile Medical Units fully supported by ONGC for a period of 5 years bring essential primary

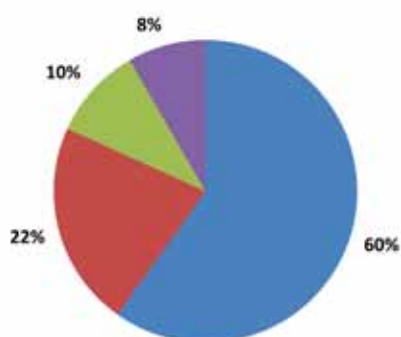

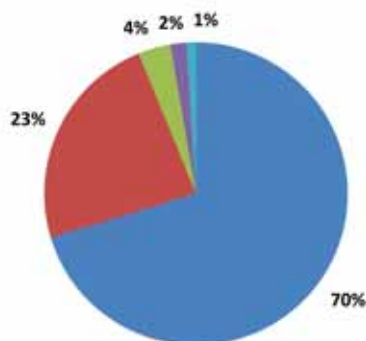

Where the money came from:

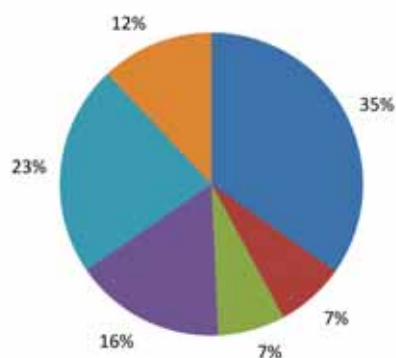
